***Membership Dues*** - If you haven't paid your membership dues yet, please send them in to Beth Joslin.



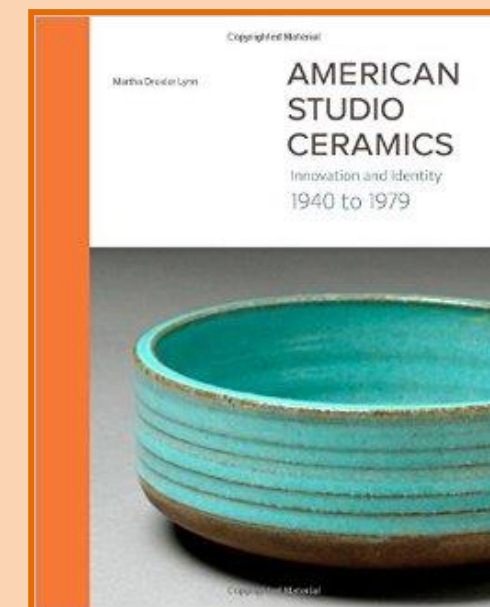
### **History of an Exhibition: The Ceramic Nationals**
